



True Goodness

Psalm 73:1-2

¹ Truly God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart. ² But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled, my steps had nearly slipped.

Psalm 73:3-4

3 For I was envious of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. 4 For they have no pangs until death; their bodies are fat and sleek.

Psalm 73:5-6

5 They are not in trouble as others are; they are not stricken like the rest of mankind. 6 Therefore pride is their necklace; violence covers them as a garment.

Psalm 73:7-8

7 Their eyes swell out through fatness; their hearts overflow with follies. 8 They scoff and speak with malice; loftily they threaten oppression.

18 Truly you set them in slippery places; you make them fall to ruin.

Psalm 73:19-20

19 How they are destroyed in a moment, swept away utterly by terrors! **20** Like a dream when one awakes, O Lord, when you rouse yourself, you despise them as phantoms.

Psalm 73:21-22

21 When my soul was embittered,
when I was pricked in heart, **22** I was
brutish and ignorant; I was like a
beast toward you.

23 Nevertheless, I am continually with you; you hold my right hand.
