


1 Peter 1:22-25 (NLT)

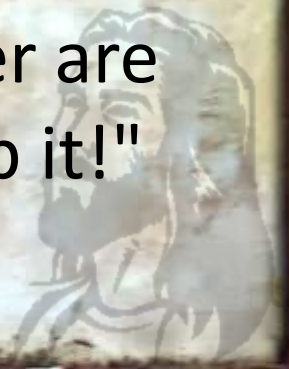

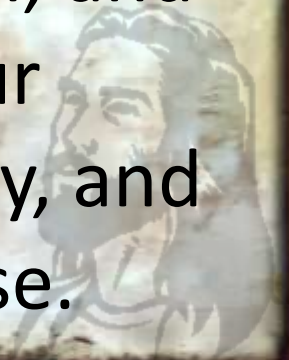
Luke 11:27-28 (ESV)


Deuteronomy 6:6-9 (ESV)

Hebrews 4:12 (ESV)

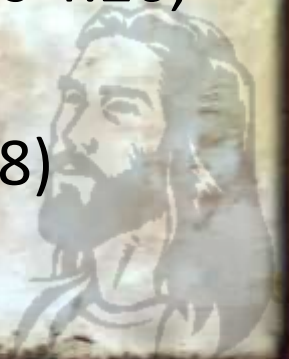

What does God's word say about these potential land mines:

- Marriage (Genesis 2:24; I Peter 3:1-7; Ephesians 5:22-33)
- Parenting (Psalm 127:3; Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21)
- Relationships with non-Believers (Matthew 5:13-16; II Corinthians 6:14-18; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)
- Sex (Genesis 1:28; Song of Solomon)

- Finances (Deuteronomy 15:6; Psalm 37:21; Proverbs 21:20; Proverbs 21:5; Matthew 6:19-24)
- Anger (Proverbs 14:29; Proverbs 15:1; Proverbs 15:8; Proverbs 19:11; Ecclesiastes 7:9; Psalm 86:15; Psalm 103:8; Psalm 145:8; Ephesians 4:26; James 1:19; Matthew 5:21-26)
- Addictions (Matthew 5:27-30; I Timothy 3:8)
- Work (Ephesians 6:5-9; Colossians 3:23)

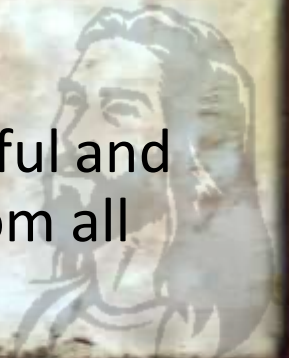


– Temptations

1 John 1:9 (ESV) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.



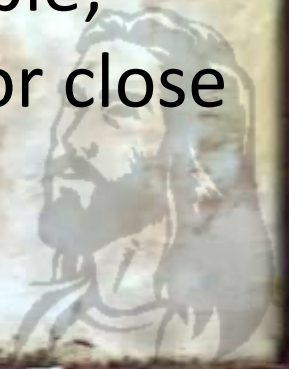
James 1:5 (ESV)
