## **Luke 18:36-37** (ESV)

**As he drew near to Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. <sup>36</sup> And hearing a crowd going by, he inquired what this meant. <sup>37</sup> They told him, “Jesus of Nazareth is passing by.”**



## **Luke 18:38-39** (ESV)

**<sup>38</sup> And he cried out, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” <sup>39</sup> And those who were in front rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he cried out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”**




**Son of David?**



## **2 Samuel 7:12-13 (ESV)**

**When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. <sup>13</sup> He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.**



## **2 Samuel 7:14-15 (ESV)**

**<sup>14</sup> I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, <sup>15</sup> but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you.**



## **2 Samuel 7:16-17 (ESV)**

**<sup>16</sup> And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.' ” <sup>17</sup> In accordance with all these words, and in accordance with all this vision, Nathan spoke to David.**

## **Psalm 51:1-3 (ESV)**

**Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. <sup>2</sup> Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! <sup>3</sup> For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.**



## **Psalm 51:4 (ESV)**

**<sup>4</sup> Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.**



## **Luke 18:40-41 (ESV)**

**<sup>40</sup> And Jesus stopped and commanded him to be brought to him. And when he came near, he asked him, <sup>41</sup> “What do you want me to do for you?” He said, “Lord, let me recover my sight.”**



## **Luke 18:42-43 (ESV)**
