


# Fulfillment



## **Luke 22:35-36 (ESV)**

**And he said to them, “When I sent you out with no moneybag or knapsack or sandals, did you lack anything?” They said, “Nothing.”<sup>36</sup> He said to them, “But now let the one who has a moneybag take it, and likewise a knapsack. And let the one who has no sword sell his cloak and buy one.”**



## **Luke 22:38** (ESV)

**And they said, “Look, Lord, here are two swords.” And he said to them, “It is enough.”**



## **1 Peter 2:21-25 (ESV)**

**For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps. <sup>22</sup> He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth.**



## **1 Peter 2:21-25 (ESV)**

**<sup>23</sup> When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.**



## **1 Peter 2:21-25 (ESV)**

**<sup>24</sup> He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. <sup>25</sup> For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.**



## **Luke 2:37** (ESV)

**“For I tell you that this Scripture must be fulfilled in me: ‘And he was numbered with the transgressors.’ For what is written about me has its fulfillment.”**



**Jesus was convinced he would soon be rejected  
and die because the Scriptures promised it.**



## **Isaiah 53:12** (ESV)

**Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.**



## **Matthew 5:17-18 (ESV)**

**“Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. <sup>18</sup> For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.”**



## **Matthew 19:3-6 (ESV)**

**And Pharisees came up to him and tested him by asking, “Is it lawful to divorce one’s wife for any cause?”**



## **Matthew 19:3-6 (ESV)**

**<sup>4</sup> He answered, “Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, <sup>5</sup> and said, ‘Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh’? <sup>6</sup> So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.”**



## **Genesis 2:24** (ESV)

**Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.**
