






Exile Living: Husbands




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“The Fall introduced distortions into the relationships between men and women. In the home, the husband’s loving, humble leadership tends to be replaced by domination or passivity;

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
the wife's intelligent, willing submission tends to be replaced by usurpation or servility.

In the church, sin inclines men towards a worldly love of power or an abdication of spiritual responsibility and

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
inclines women to resist limitations on their roles or to neglect the use of their gifts in appropriate ministries.” –Danvers Statement



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grow in willing, joyful submission to their husbands' leadership.


In the church, redemption in Christ gives men and women an equal share in the blessings of salvation;
