# 1 Corinthians 5:6-11 (ESV)

Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? <sup>7</sup> Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

# 1 Corinthians 5:6-11 (ESV)

<sup>8</sup> Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. <sup>9</sup> I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people—

# 1 Corinthians 5:6-11 (ESV)

<sup>10</sup> not at all meaning the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world. <sup>11</sup> But now I am writing to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of brother if he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed,

# 1 Corinthians 5:6-11 (ESV)

he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler—not even to eat with such a one.

## Exodus 1:9-11 (ESV)

And he said to his people, “Behold, the people of Israel are too many and too mighty for us. <sup>10</sup> Come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and, if war breaks out,

they join our enemies and fight against us and escape from the land.”<sup>11</sup> Therefore they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with heavy burdens. They built for Pharaoh store cities, Pithom and Raamses.

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

Now on the first day of Unleavened Bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying, “Where will you have us prepare for you to eat the Passover?”<sup>18</sup> He said, “Go into the city to a certain man and say to him, ‘The Teacher says, My time is at hand.

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

I will keep the Passover at your house with my disciples.’ ”<sup>19</sup> And the disciples did as Jesus had directed them, and they prepared the Passover.<sup>20</sup> When it was evening, he reclined at table with the twelve.<sup>21</sup> And as they were eating, he said,

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

“Truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me.”<sup>22</sup> And they were very sorrowful and began to say to him one after another, “Is it I, Lord?”<sup>23</sup> He answered, “He who has dipped his hand in the dish with me will betray me.

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

<sup>24</sup> The Son of Man goes as it is written of him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been better for that man if he had not been born.” <sup>25</sup> Judas, who would betray him, answered, “Is it I, Rabbi?”

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

He said to him, “You have said so.”

<sup>26</sup> Now as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, “Take, eat; this is my body.”

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

<sup>27</sup> And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, “Drink of it, all of you, <sup>28</sup> for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

## Matthew 26:17-29 (ESV)

<sup>29</sup> I tell you I will not drink again of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.”

# 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 (ESV)

The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ?

The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?

<sup>17</sup> Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body,

# 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (ESV)


for we all partake of the one bread. For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, <sup>24</sup> and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said,

## 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (ESV)

“This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”<sup>25</sup> In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.”

# 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (ESV)

<sup>26</sup> For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

# 1 Corinthians 11:27-29 (ESV)

Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

# 1 Corinthians 11:27-29 (ESV)

<sup>29</sup> For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.
