#### Galatians 3:1-6 (ESV)

O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. <sup>2</sup> Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? <sup>3</sup> Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit,

are you now being perfected by the flesh? <sup>4</sup> Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? <sup>5</sup> Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—

<sup>6</sup> just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"?

#### Romans 10:17 (ESV)

"So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

# Galatians 3:7-9 (ESV)

Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. 8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed."

# Galatians 3:7-9 (ESV)

<sup>9</sup> So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.
