## **Galatians 3:23-29 (ESV)**

**Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed. <sup>24</sup> So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.**

## **Galatians 3:23-29 (ESV)**

**<sup>25</sup> But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian, <sup>26</sup> for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. <sup>27</sup> For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.**

## **Galatians 4:1-7 (ESV)**

**I mean that the heir, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything, <sup>2</sup> but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father.**

**<sup>3</sup> In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world.**

## **Galatians 4:1-7 (ESV)**

**<sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.**

## **Galatians 4:1-7 (ESV)**

**<sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, “Abba! Father!” <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.**

# **1 Peter 1:3-9 (ESV)**

**Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, <sup>4</sup> to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,**



# **1 Peter 1:3-9 (ESV)**

**<sup>5</sup> who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. <sup>6</sup> In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials,**

# **1 Peter 1:3-9 (ESV)**

**<sup>7</sup> so that the tested genuineness of your faith—  
more precious than gold that perishes though it  
is tested by fire—may be found to result in  
praise and glory and honor at the revelation of  
Jesus Christ.**

# **1 Peter 1:3-9 (ESV)**

**<sup>8</sup> Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, <sup>9</sup> obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.**

**Christians are no longer slaves under the law but are sons and daughters united in Christ.**
